



## 2019-2020 Colorado Preschool Program (CPP) Application Process Guidelines

Adams 12 Five Star Schools understands the importance of early childhood education and provides preschool at various elementary schools and community partner preschools throughout the school district.

Some Important Facts:

- Students **must** reside within the Adams 12 Five Star School Boundaries. Please use the boundary locator to determine if you live within Adams 12 Boundaries [www.adams12.org/departments/admissions/boundary-locator](http://www.adams12.org/departments/admissions/boundary-locator).
- Students **must** qualify with state criteria for eligibility into the Colorado Preschool Program at no cost to the family.
- Priority enrollment is given to students who turn 4 years old on or before October 1, 2019, and all 4 year old students must meet at least one of the qualifying risk factors.
- All qualifying 3 year olds (three on or before October 1, 2019 and meet at least three of the risk factors) will be placed on a waitlist and will be enrolled if space becomes available.

In order for an enrollment application to be considered, families must attend a screening day and provide the following **at the time of the screening**. **Your enrollment will not be considered 'complete' until all required paperwork has been received.**

1. Adams 12 Five Star Schools Preschool Enrollment Packet. Packet available online at [www.adams12.org/sites/default/files/uploads/documents/Preschool%20Enrollment%20Packet%20English%20Jan%202019.pdf](http://www.adams12.org/sites/default/files/uploads/documents/Preschool%20Enrollment%20Packet%20English%20Jan%202019.pdf) or will be available at the screening (*Incomplete paperwork will not be accepted and will need to be brought back at a later date*)
2. Family Economic Survey (to verify eligibility for low income status, available at the screening)
3. Copy of child's government issued birth certificate
4. Copy of child's immunization record
5. One proof of residency, original or online print out, for current or last month with parent's name and address clearly marked (examples below):
  - Electric, cable, internet, trash or water bill;
  - Mortgage statement; rental, lease or purchase agreements;
  - Homeowners or renters insurance

Our placement process has changed for the 2019-2020 School Year. We will no longer be placing children on a first-come first-served basis. Placements will be determined by July 15, 2019, after all screening dates have been completed.
